BUSINESS SUMMARY

Equipment arriving on site is registered and then assessed for the most suitable recycling route in accordance with WEEE provisions.

The majority of equipment currently collected is consigned for physical destruction with recovery of the various material components. Others may be approved for consumer reuse or donated to charities.

Most equipment is stripped down with any hazardous elements removed e.g. lithium cells on the motherboards. The material is then separated and processed. Ferrous, non-ferrous and precious metals are recovered and sent for recycling where possible.

Cathode Ray Tubes, Batteries, Toner, Fluorescent tubes etc. receive specialised treatment.

ASSET MANAGEMENT

MGH Scotland controls all processes with the use of a bespoke database warehouse and asset management system developed for quality, environmental care and client satisfaction. This allows us to produce waste, sales and consignment reports for all clients, with a sound audit trail extending from pallets of equipment right down to individual components

You can be assured that every piece of equipment collected by MGH Scotland is entered onto an individual client database detailing make, model and serial number. This information is retained with MGH and copied to clients as required.

Comprehensive monthly reports on waste stream are readily available.

DATA DESTRUCTION

Removing data from a hard drive is not a simple matter of deleting files. The process of complete and secure data destruction is a sophisticated procedure requiring significant time and resources.

MGH offer a secure data destruction service on site.

The data destruction facility can be in conjunction with other recycling activities or as a stand alone service.

The service is designed to ensure full, irrecoverable removal or destruction of any data contained on all types of magnetic, solid state and optical storage media.

Our computer hard disk drive erasure consists of a minimum 3 pass binary overwrite wipe to UK Government standards.

We fully understand the sensitivity of data on computer storage devices and the need for confidentiality and consequently offer a service that includes

- Delivered direct to our secure data wipe facility
- Ability to handle up to 6000 drives per week
